Work with radar In-Service Engineering Agent (ISEA) personnel to maintain status of technical assistance efforts and parts requisitions required to achieve Casualty Correction (CASCOR). Develop report formats to adequately convey fleet support status to various levels of leadership and present those reports when necessary.
